Page A-1, Eclipse. Fitted with a ram bow.

Page A-3, Izumo. The correct designation for the 8in/45 guns is "EOC Pattern S"

Page A-4, Tsushima. Change the Damage point Breakdown to: 41/82/122/147/163.

Page A-4, Chiyoada. Change the 4.7inch Gun arcs from to "F/PW/SW/2P/2S/PA/SA/A"

Page A-6, Chihaya. Change the remark "Laid down before 1895, special damage modifier of -25%" to "Laid down before 1925, special damage modifier of -15%." She was laid down in 1898. The damage points (84 total) are correct.

Page A-6, Tatsuta: Change her size class from "C/Small" to "D/Small"

Page A-9, Tri Sviatitelia: Change "F/A(2)2 305mm/35 Pattern 1885" to "F/A(2)2 305mm/40 Pattern 1892."

Page A-11, Dvenadstat Apostolov: Change "F/A(2)2 305mm/35 Pattern 1885 (SL1)" to "F/A(2)2 305mm/30 Pattern 1877."

Page A-11, Ekaterina II: Change "PW/SW/A(2)3 305mm/35 Pattern 1885 (SL1)" to "PW/SW/A(2)3 305mm/30 Pattern 1877."
