HMGS Special Guest Dr. Norman Friedman


Dr. Norman Friedman is a distinguished author, historian and naval analyst. He has written numerous books and articles on naval history, strategy and tactics. His forthcoming book on anti-submarine warfare (ASW) during the Cold War examines the different perceptions and realities between the Soviet Union and the United States regarding ASW strategy, tactics, and the technological innovations to support them. From the U.S. perspective, Cold War ASW changed the Maritime Strategy from a way of gaining naval freedom of action (to affect the outcome of a European ground war) to a way of affecting the Soviet leadership, hence either deterring war or quickly ending it.

Chile Crisis: No One Expects the Spanish Inquisition

Event: 268 - Dawn of the Battleship

Time: 2:00 PM Location: Federal A/FD-1

Remarks: The recent War of the Pacific left Chile victorious and Bolivia cut off from the sea and under Chile's thumb. When faced with increased Chilean economic pressure, Bolivia in desperation turns to Spain for rescue. Fueled by a recent victory in Morocco over the Rif and encouraged by a resurgent and technology savvy Inquisition, Madrid agrees. But Santiago is still flexing her muscle with the necessary ships to meet a new Spanish 'armada'.

Remarks: As part of the Soviet grand plan for emplacing modern armaments in Cuba, the 69th Submarine Torpedo Brigade is deployed to Cuba in early October. However, on Oct 22nd, the US announces that a naval quarantine will be imposed on Cuba to prevent the arrival of Soviet weapons, especially ballistic missiles that can reach America. This places the naval forces of both nations in direct opposition at sea with possible dire consequences.

Convoy Crisis: Convoy HG76 vs. Seeräuber

Remarks: The battle for HG76 has hit the high-water mark. Over the last six days the Germans have been frustrated in their attacks on the convoy and four U-boats have been lost for only two merchants sunk. However the Germans have inflicted serious damage on the escort group, which has suffered two collisions, one destroyer sunk and the loss of the escort carrier *Audacity*. As more U-boats arrive for yet another thrust, the British prepare to beat back the hungry Huns one more time.

Adriatic Scrambled Nightmare

Event: 460 - Command at Sea

Remarks: By 1943, Axis forces were running heavily defended convoys through the Kvaneric Channel Islands on the west coast of Yugoslavia between Zadar and Rijeka. The Allied forces were constantly intercepting these convoys. Scrambled actions with a high probability of friendly fire were frequent.
